

### Diagnostic Referral Guidelines

The following is a list of appropriate diagnoses and events for referral to Case Management:

- Coma (after 3 days duration)
- Hospital admission greater than 10 days or \$25,000
- Head injury with admission to ICU (after 5 days duration)
- Spinal cord injury
- Burns (3<sup>rd</sup> degree)
- Neonates with:
  - Hospital stay over 5 days
  - Multiple congenital anomalies
  - Stay exceeding \$25,000
- Ventilator dependent
- AIDS (requiring complex care)
- Hospice (including AIDS, Cancer, COPD, and other terminal disease)
- Multiple admissions (3 or more in any 6 month period)
  - Examples, not limitations: Diabetes, COPD, ER
- Skilled nursing facility admission
- Home healthcare
- Complex medical equipment/supply needs
- Transplants

All cases are subject to evaluation by the appropriate staff for case management intervention.
